ECE REACH is an entry-level pathway & career development opportunity in Early Childhood Education for Latina mothers. In this program you will be offered academic courses, a paid internship, mentorship, training, and job placement.

This Program Helps You:

Participants will:

- Register and attend an orientation
- Attend all class meetings virtually
- Meet 1:1 with a mentor and workforce success coach
- Participate in weekly work-based learning (*internship*)
- Attend tutoring supports (*as needed*)

Participant Benefits:

- Earn 12 ECE college credits in three semesters, and receive a \$1,500 stipend per semester
- Receive academic tutoring and support
- Complete 50 days of classroom experience
- Obtain an Associate Teacher permit through the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC)
- Receive a CPR/First Aid certificate
- Receive a Child Abuse Mandated Reported Certificate

Job Placement

Once you complete 12 college units, start your career as:

- An ECE Teacher's Assistant in a center-based program, starting compensation \$54,600 (\$28/hr)
- A Family Childcare Provider
- An Independent contractor
