We place AmeriCorps Seniors volunteers (55+ older) into the local San Francisco Senior Companion Program (SCP).



The AmeriCorps Seniors Senior Companion Program (SCP), operated by Felton Institute, is designed to assist and encourage homebound seniors to engage in personal and community activities, cultivating friendships that can last a lifetime.

Receive a small, TAX-FREE hourly stipend that will not affect governmental benefits!

Who is Eligible?

- Age 55 or older
- Max income of:
 - Single: \$2,430/month or \$29,160/year
 - Married: \$3,287/month or \$39,440/year

*Medical expenses can be deducted from your income to meet limit requirements
